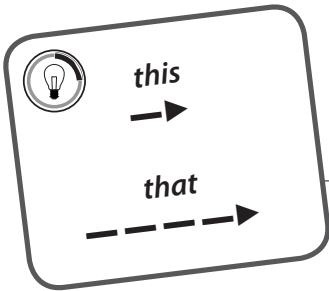
A supermarket is low. The Eiffel tower is high.

Is the ceiling high in the living room?	<i>Yes, the ceiling's high in the living room.</i>
Is a supermarket low?	<i>Yes, a supermarket is low.</i>
Is the Eiffel tower high?	<i>Yes, the Eiffel tower is high.</i>
Is a supermarket high?	<i>No, a supermarket isn't high. It's low.</i>
Is the Eiffel tower low?	<i>No, the Eiffel tower isn't low. It's high.</i>
