Have you prepared any reports today? What were they about? How many did you prepare?	Yes, I've prepared some reports today. They were about our sales abroad. I prepared two reports.

Where have you been?	I've been to the cinema.
What did you see?	I saw 'Avatar'.
Did you enjoy it?	Yes, I enjoyed it a lot.

We also use the word lean in *Business English* for lean management or lean production. Lean management was developed in Japan and refers to an approach in which we reduce the time of delivery from the supplier, and the time between the production stages and we aim to constantly improve the quality.

#### Korean cuisine

'Have you eaten?' – is the polite way to greet another person in South Korea. Striking, especially when you visit the country and see how wealthy and prosperous the community is. Technologically advanced farming, an abundance of food at every corner, traditional *sijang* markets, Michelin quality street food vendors. At first glance, people appear sated and happy.

One might consider it an invitation to dine at a restaurant. They couldn't be more wrong. Though it sounds a bit awkward to a European, African or American ear, 'Have you eaten?' still remains a mere greeting. What are its origins, then?

The first half of the 20th century was a time of devastating disasters and hostility for Koreans. From the Japanese occupation, through the tragedies of WWII, Korea immediately dived into the Cold War and the dire conflict between the North and South, which resulted in the split of the nation. Food supply was severely limited, and many families were only able to eat once a day. Not only did they eat fewer meals, but also the nutrition worsened. Meat and fresh vegetables became rather scarce. These events impacted the cuisine and led Koreans to develop a great concern over their fellow citizens' access to food, reflected in the greeting.

South Korea underwent an outstanding transformation from a ruined country to one of the world's leading economies. The development of intelligent agriculture contributed to the reduction of hunger and changed the cooking style. Once based on grains, with a considerable consumption of rice, the cuisine shifted to include a variety of meats, predominantly beef and pork, tonnes of vegetables and seafood. Koreans also realised that their cuisine, if properly advertised, can be a substantial source of national income. Hence, so many Korean dishes have become so popular in every corner of the globe.

Perhaps the best recognised dish of Korean origin is *kimchi*. Basically, it's fermented cabbage and cucumber with various flavour ingredients, including spices, garlic and pepper, often ginger and mustard. The dish has gained sensational and widespread popularity. Essentially, it accompanies every meal in Korea. Its value depends on the vitamins it contains, as well as on a low calorie and cholesterol content. Each Korean family has special kimchi freezers to keep the snack in stock. This is fundamental if your family consumes on average 50 kg of kimchi annually.
